



June 22 & 23, 2017 Barn Hunt Training Sessions

Introduction to Barn Hunt: For all breeds and sizes of dogs that are new to the sport of Barn Hunt. Dogs will be exposed to the rats in both a cage and a tube. Time will be spent preparing the dog to enter trials at both the Instinct and Novice Levels. Individuals will also be given instruction on how to be a rat wrangler.

June 22: Noon to 1:30 PM & 6:30 to 8 PM **Limit 6 dogs per 90 minute session \$35 per dog**
June 23: 2:30 to 4 PM

Finding the Rat Sessions: Having trouble determining when your dog has located a rat or just a tube of bedding? These sessions will allow you to observe your dog at rat and bedding tubes to allow you to praise your dog at the rat and help you to better identify the type of mark given by your dog. If needed, time will also be spent in teaching the dog how to complete more advanced tunnels.

June 22: 2 PM, 3 PM, 4 PM, & 6 PM **Limit 3 dogs per 60 minute session \$25 per dog**
June 23: 9 AM, 10 AM, & 1 PM
