Donna excels at bringing training techniques to her agility students and places emphasis on the handler-dog relationship. She has many students who came out of Novice A/Starters classes, and are now competing successfully in Excellent/Masters classes. Her students have earned MACH/ADCH titles and have competed at the National level. Many students have trained with her for numerous years and with several generations of their agility partners.
