Directions to Animal Emergency Veterinary Clinic of York: Start out going southeast on Mt. Airy Rd. toward Stone Jug Rd. Turn right onto Rosstown Rd./PA-177. Turn left onto Carlisle Rd./PA-74. Continue approximately 13 miles, turn right onto S. Queen St./PA-74. 1640 S. Queen Street is approximately 1.7 miles. Total travel distance: 18.61 miles / Travel time: 38 minutes.

ROUTES TO THE TRIAL

From I-83:

I-83 to Exit 32 (Newbery exit). Northbound – At the light at the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Rt. 382 North to Lewisberry. Go approximately 3 miles to the flashing traffic light and turn left onto Rt. 177 South toward Rossville. Go approximately 4 miles and turn right on Mt Airy Rd (across from Gifford Pinchot State Park). Continue approximately 1.7 miles to the site on the left. Southbound - At the light at the bottom of the ramp turn right onto Rt 382 North to Lewisberry. Follow directions above.

From Route 15: Take Bowmansdale exit Rt. 114 towards Ski Roundtop. At traffic light at the bottom of the hill, proceed straight on South Market St. DO NOT FOLLOW 114. Continue straight about 2.3 miles on South Market St which will become North York Rd. Turn left on East Mt. Airy Rd (at Mt. Pleasant Church of God) and go approximately 4.5 miles. You will pass Ski Roundtop on the right. Continue to a “T” intersection and turn right on Pinetown Rd. Take the first left onto Mt Airy Rd. Site is immediately on the right.

If using a GPS: Choose 730 Mt Airy Rd, Lewisberry, PA. Make sure you do not use East Mt Airy Rd.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to the Annex Building. The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crating area. Tarps must be placed under all crates. Dogs will not be permitted to stay overnight in the crating area.

Seating space will be available at ringside. Please no oversized chairs, reclining chairs or tables in this area. Please, no dogs permitted in front row.

PARKING:

RV/OVERSIZED VEHICLE PARKING: RV's and Oversized Vehicles are not allowed to park in the regular parking spaces. Oversized Vehicles are defined as those vehicles that do not easily fit in a parking space either by width or length. No trailers are permitted.

Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles **MUST** be kept clean at all times. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. BVTC & GSCA will not be responsible for loss by burglary, fire, or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

Exhibitors are governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense. HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only.. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

OBSTACLES & RING CONDITIONS: Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of Regulations for Agility Trials and are supplied by Bella Vista Training Center.. Electronic timers will be used. Rubberized contacts will be used. All classes will take place indoors on Game Day Grass by AstroTurf. Ring size will be 78' x 105'.

ENTRY FEE: \$25.00 for the first entry of a dog each day; \$20.00 for the second entry of the same dog each day; \$15.00 each for the third, fourth and fifth entries of the same dog each day. Entry fees include the AKC recording fee of \$3.50 per dog, per day for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog per day. All checks are cashed upon receipt.

CLOSING DATE: Thursday, September 13, 2018 at 6 p.m., after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 14 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

MOVE-UPS & CANCELLATIONS: In order for move-ups and cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received. No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement. Move Up deadline is September 24, 2018.

REFUNDS: No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any

other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. All refund requests received prior to the close of entries will be charged a \$5.00 per day processing fee.

A refund of entries minus \$20 per dog per day for injured dogs/bitches in season will be granted when a veterinarian's letter is presented as proof to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. Letter must be on official Vet Letter Head. No copies, facsimiles or emails.

TRIAL REGULATIONS - NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

RETURNED CHECKS AND DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$30.00 will be made for each returned check or declined credit card charge.

TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.

NO ON-LINE ENTRIES.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE. ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS-Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

EVENT COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. See "Refunds".

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, ILP, PAL, or be FSS breeds eligible to compete. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided the listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial is open to mixed breed dogs.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE will be made when entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH at all times except when in the ring or in the designated warm-up area.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
