HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL**

dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to

leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. YCDTC, Bella Vista and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The YCDTC and/or BVTC reserve the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the YCDTC, BVTC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

YCDTC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials offering mixed breed entries), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Move-Ups

Per American Kennel Club Regulations for Agility Trials, dogs may be moved up to a higher class, at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title. Verbal move-ups will not be accepted. Move-ups are due in writing by Monday, November 13, 2017.

<u>Day-to Day Move-ups</u> are only allowed for dogs entered at the set of back-to-back agility trials for succeeding days of that set of back-to-back agility trials. Move-ups must be submitted in writing at the trial within 15 minutes of the last run of the trial day for the following day(s) and cannot be conveyed via fax, email, phone or verbally. REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

All refund requests received prior to the close of entries will be charged a \$5.00 per day processing fee.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to the Annex Building. The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crating area. Tarps must be place under all crates. X-pens only permitted with prior approval from BVTC. Please email trial secretary with all requests at trialsec@bvtrainingcenter.com. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight in the crating area.

Seating space will be available at ringside. Please no oversized chairs, reclining chairs or tables in this area. Please, no dogs permitted in front row.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs.

PARKING

Exhibitors are governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense. PLEASE NOTE: A limited number of handicap spaces are available. They will be available on a first-come basis. A valid handicap plate/placard must be on each vehicle using these spaces.

RV/OVERSIZED VEHICLE PARKING: RV's and Oversized Vehicles are not allowed to park in the regular parking spaces. Oversized Vehicles are defined as those vehicles that do not easily fit in a parking space either by width or length. No trailers.

Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles MUST be kept clean at all times. All vehicles will be parked at owner's risk. BVTC, KCDV, & YCDTC will not be responsible for loss by burglary, fire, or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

Leashes

All dogs must be on leash at the trial. Retractable leashes are not allowed in the building. Dogs may only be off leash while running the course or at the practice jump. No exhibitors or dogs are allowed behind the row of pine trees to the rear of the Arena.

Move-up entries for subsequent days must be delivered to the Trial Secretary within 30 minutes of the conclusion of judging of the class they are moving up from.
