**National Owner-Handled Series  
Saturday & Sunday, October 3 & 4, 2020**

The AKC Owner/Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners who are not professional handlers\*. All dogs that are owner/handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers meet the requirements for this competition.

Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner/Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box at the bottom of the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book and the catalog.

**Dogs must be handled throughout the competition by an eligible owner. Professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any competition during the entire show.**

- The Owner Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and winners of the non-regular classes.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition eligible, it will automatically be Owner Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed/Variety winner is Owner-Handled competition ineligible and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety is eligible, them it will compete against the eligible undefeated exhibits of the opposite sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If the Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed/Variety are both ineligible and Select Dog and Select Bitch are both eligible, the judge is to choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the Selects and eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects is eligible, excuse all dogs of the same sex and then choose Best Owner-Handled exhibit from the remaining dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch are ineligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog remaining in the ring including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as Owner-Handled Best of Breed/Variety.
- If there is no eligible dog competing in the Best of Breed or in Best of Winners Competition, Owner Handled Best of Breed will not be awarded.

\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay or received payment for handling a dog.

## ROUTES TO THE SHOW

**From I-83** – Proceed to Exit 32 (Newberrytown Exit). Route 382 North to Lewisberry, approximately 3 miles to flashing traffic light. South (left) on Route 177 toward Rossville; approximately 3 miles. Right on Mount Airy Rd. (across from Pinchot State Park Office). Drive approximately 1.7 miles (road is twisty). BVTC is on the left.

**From US-15** – Route 15 to Mechanicsburg – Bowmansdale Exit. Take Route 114 toward Ski Roundtop. At traffic light at the bottom of hill, proceed straight on South Market Street. **Do NOT follow Route 114**; continue straight about 2.3 miles on South Market (it will become North York Road). Left on East Mount Airy Road (at Mount Pleasant Church of God) and go 4.5 miles. Pass Ski Roundtop (on right) and continue to “T” intersection. Right on Pinetown Road. First left on Mount Airy Road. BVTC is immediately on the right.

**From US-15** – Drive to Rossville four-way traffic light. Drive north on Route 177. As soon as you cross over Pinchot Lake, take first left turn onto Pinetown Road. Follow Pinetown Road to Mount Airy Road. Turn right onto Mount Airy Road. BVTC is on the right.

## COVID GUIDELINES

### Attendee Check-In

- **A signed COVID-19 waiver is required for both event days to access the show site. A copy of the waivers can be found on page 7.**
- When you arrive in the morning, head to the check in station to turn in your signed waiver for that day and have your temperature checked by a volunteer.
- Once we have your waiver and have confirmed that you are not running a fever, you will be given a wristband that grants access to the building for rest of that day and your armbands and catalog (if applicable).  
**If you are running a fever, you will not be permitted to attend either day of shows. You will be given a form to petition GDCPA for a refund of eligible entry fees and asked to leave the show site immediately.**

### Mask Policy

- **Properly fitting masks which cover the wearer’s nose and mouth are required at all times in all public areas and buildings.**
- Masks with one-way valves are **not acceptable**.
- GDCPA will consider medically-supported exceptions to mask policy (i.e. face shields) on a case-by-case basis; petition must be received by show secretary no later than 1 week prior to event to allow sufficient time for club review and decision. Contact show secretary for details.

### Social Distancing

- **6’ social distancing will be enforced in buildings and on show grounds.** Please note that this is the \*minimum\* social distance. We encourage all attendees to maximize social distancing whenever possible.

### Additional COVID-19 Precautions

1. **If you feel at all unwell, please do not** come to the shows. Stay home, take care of your health, then contact the show secretary to obtain a form to petition GDCPA for a refund of eligible entry fees.
2. **If you have tested positive for COVID-19 and do not have evidence of a subsequent negative test, please do not** come to the shows. Contact the show secretary to obtain a form to petition GDCPA for a refund of eligible entry fees.
3. **Please pay attention to signs, markers, cones, and other indicators of traffic flow and other social distancing measures.**
4. **Dogs no longer required for judging will be excused.** Please pick up any ribbons you have been awarded and head over to the photographer or exit the building.
5. **Live spectators in the Arena will be limited to the immediate owners of the dogs in the class being judged and the following class (which will be staging in the Arena).**
6. The Annex will be available for day crating and staging of dogs not in the class immediately next to be judged. **We understand that many dogs will not have had much opportunity to acquire show experience this year, so if you believe that your dog needs to be in the building with their handler/owner for an extended period of time in order to get settled, please let the show secretary know (ahead of time) so that the show committee can assess the number of dogs in this situation and figure out how best to help every dog put their best paw forward while keeping their humans safe.**
7. We will make every attempt to provide a live video feed in another venue area to minimize people coming in and out of the building to gauge where we are at with the judging. **(AKC has granted permission to do so as this is part of our COVID-19 plan, however, recording any part of the live feed is strictly prohibited and will result in disciplinary action for those individuals from the AKC.**
8. We will also be using a simple application called Remind to broadcast announcements and live updates from ringside to event attendees to help streamline preparation and staging for subsequent classes. You will be sent more information about this free tool as well as an invitation to join the event "group" before the event date.
9. It will not be necessary to wait for the judge to complete their judging assignment to have a win picture taken. We will take pictures of our judges separately.
10. **Wash your hands thoroughly and frequently. There will be hand sanitizer stations located throughout the venue. Please use them.**

**Non-adherence to these guidelines or any guidance provided by a member of the show committee, ring steward, judge or BVTC Representative will result in immediate action from the Show Committee, up to and including a bench hearing.**

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**ENTRY FEE: \$30.00 for the first entry of each dog** (including \$.50 A.K.C. recording fee & \$3.00 A.K.C. Event Service Fee). AN AKC RECORDING FEE OF \$.50 & an AKC EVENT SERVICE FEE OF \$3.00 is required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show. All Recording Fees are paid to the AKC.

**OPENING DATE for entries 9:00 am, Friday, August 28, 2020.**

**CLOSING DATE for entries 9:00 PM, Wednesday, September 16, 2020** or when the numerical limit is reached (at Show Secretary's office) after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 14, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

**SHOW HOURS** are 7:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M.

UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED. ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a \$20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable via email. The person accompanying a dog must provide confirmation of entry and identification (upon request) before the dog will be received. SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGEMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR within a reasonable time, please notify GDCPA Show Secretary at (215) 908-6369.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, GDCPA will strive to maximize the amount refunded to exhibitors.

#### **CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.**

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging but must wait to enter Staging Areas until they are summoned by a member of the Show Committee.

**DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

**JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT** will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

### **BELLA VISTA POLICIES**

**We are very fortunate to have found such a nice venue for our specialties and we would like to maintain our good standing with the owners so that we will be welcome to hold events here again in the future. Please carefully read through and adhere to the following venue-specific policies.**

#### **“P” Policy**

**POTTY** your dog before entering the building.

**PLAN** breaks in your training/showing to take your dog outside to eliminate.

**PAY** a \$5 fee for any mistakes (dog urinates, defecates or vomits in the building).

**PLACE** all waste outside and follow the posted clean up procedure.

**PENALTIES** for non-payment and/or inadequate clean-up will range from increased fees to excusal from the building.

**PLEASE note: Repeat offenders may lose the privilege to train and/or attend events at Bella Vista Training Center.**

### **General Facility**

**Abuse of equipment will not be tolerated**, and any costs associated with damage will be the responsibility of the individual renting the space.

**Facility and/or equipment issues must be reported immediately to Bella Vista at 717-515-5146.**

**Smoking/vaping is not permitted in any Bella Vista Training Center building (including bathrooms) or outdoor area. If you must smoke/vape, please do so inside your vehicle. Smokers must discard of all waste safely in an appropriate container.**

### **Dog Rules**

**Dogs must be under control at all times.**

**Flexi/retractable style leashes may not be used inside the buildings or within 100 feet of the entrances of any building.**

**Dogs may not be off-leash at any time for all AKC events.**

**Please clean up after yourself and your dog – both inside and outside.** All waste goes into outdoor trash cans. Only bottles and cans go into the blue recycle containers. If you need supplies to clean up after your dog, they are located near the doors. Please ask if you do not find the materials you need.

**Do not allow dogs to urinate on the buildings, trash cans or cones.**

### **Dog Areas**

**Dogs may be walked in all areas in front of the Arena, Kennel and the Annex up to the public road.**

**Please do not walk your dog behind any building.**

**Please do not walk your dog on the adjoining private properties.**

**Dogs are not permitted in the fenced-in areas.**

**Anyone caught trespassing on the neighbors' properties will be immediately banned from all events at Bella Vista.**

**Please note that all public areas are under 24-hour video surveillance. Any individual identified as failing to observe these rules will be subject to a minimum fine of \$50 and may be denied future access to our properties and services.**
