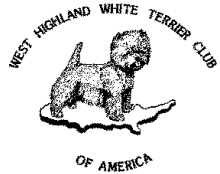


ENTRY METHOD: **FIRST RECEIVED ENTRIES**

Transfer (Move-ups)

Transfers for trial 1 for day 1 must be received in writing by the Trial Secretary by November 8 by 6pm. (transfers by e-mail to scoresmore@comcast.net are acceptable). Transfers for trial 2 on day 1 must be received in writing by the Trial Secretary at the show site no later than 30 minutes after trial 1 is finished.

You may enter all offered classes with the same dog!

(To be eligible for Advanced you must have earned Novice)

Novice A Classes are open to dogs who have not completed any title for that particular element, and who have never worked as professional detection dogs. **Novice B** Classes are open to all dogs. Dogs who have earned titles in competing organizations are encouraged to enter the B section. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es) / divisions. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of qualifying scores.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Chapter 2 Section 3. Describes the physical condition of the dog.

Condition of the Dog. Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are allowed to enter.

Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Entries close at 6:00 p.m. on October 18, 2021 at the home of the Trial Secretary after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted, except as provided in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

Entries without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify Bonnie Reifsnyder, Trial Secretary.

Entries not on official AKC entry forms or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

Express entries: Please use "release signature" or the entry will be delayed. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

A **New Title rosette** will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

WAIT LIST INFORMATION

West Highland White Terrier Club of America is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of **25 entries per day** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to October 2, 2021. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on October 18, 2021. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund. Wait List entries will be worked up to 7 days before the trial.

STAGING AREA, HANDLER'S BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The **Handler's Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

Chapter 5 Section 34. Warm-Up Area.

One labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that other may be able to use the warm-up area as well. Clubs may also place blank containers in the warm-up area if they choose

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. Chapter 3 Section 15. It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future. "NO smoking is allowed in the property"

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectator Area. We have very limited space for spectators at this trial. Only containers, exteriors classes can be viewed. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be ask to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

Crating space. There will be **NO** inside carting. Be prepared to work your dog out of your vehicle. There is no shade so please be prepared for any weather condition to keep you and your dog comfortable.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. **Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site.** In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The West Highland White Terrier Club of America, Bella Vista Training Center & Scores N More and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The West Highland White Terrier Club of America **reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression.** No one shall have any recourse or claim against the The West Highland White Terrier Club of America or any official thereof. The competitor expressly agree that AKC and The West Highland White Terrier Club of America, Bella Vista Training Center & Scores N More and its assignees or any other person, or persons, of said groups, shall not be held liable personally, or collectively, under any circumstances, for injury, and/or damage to her/himself, for loss or injury to property, whether due to uncontrolled dogs or negligence of any member of said groups, or any other cause, or causes. The competitor also agrees to assume all financial liability that may be incurred by the WHWTCA, Bella Vista Training Center & Scores N More due to the actions of themselves or their dogs regardless of the cause.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses.

Please see Chapter 5, Section 9 of the Regulations for AKC Scent Work for requirements and prohibitions regarding collars, leashes, and harnesses.

All dogs must be on leash at all times.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical conditions are eligible to a 50% refund by supplying the Trial Secretary with a certificate from your veterinarian dated the day of the trial(s).

Bitches in season: All but \$5.00 of each entry fee (per run) may be refunded for bitches who come in season after the closing date by supplying the Trial Secretary with a certificate from your veterinarian dated the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitor check-in: At check-in you will receive your armband number, event catalog will be for sale for \$5.00. Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.

Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging are free to leave the trial side. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in judging ring when their classes are called.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Scent Work Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website.

Exhibitors MUST check-in Each trial they are entered.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

DIRECTIONS CAN BE FOUND VIA GPS

From I-83: I-83 to Exit 32 (Newbery exit). **Northbound** – At the light at the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Rt. 382 North to Lewisberry. Go approximately 3 miles to the flashing traffic light and turn left onto Rt. 177 South toward Rossville. Go approximately 4 miles and turn right on Mt Airy Rd (across from Gifford Pinchot State Park). Continue approximately 1.7 miles to the site on the left.

Southbound - At the light at the bottom of the ramp turn right onto Rt 382 North to Lewisberry. Follow directions above.

From US-15: Take Bowmansdale exit Rt. 114 towards Ski Roundtop. At traffic light at the bottom of the hill, proceed straight on South Market St. DO NOT FOLLOW 114. Continue straight about 2.3 miles on South Market St which will become North York Rd. Turn left on East Mt. Airy Rd (at Mt. Pleasant Church of God) and go approximately 4.5 miles. You will pass Ski Roundtop on the right. Continue to a "T" intersection and turn right on Pinetown Rd. Take the first left onto Mt Airy Rd. Site is immediately on the right.

AGREEMENT
