CHARITY CHALLENGE FEATURES:

#1. The Opportunity to give back to the dog world & the community!

At least \$2 from each run will benefit the dog charity chosen by the hosting club. Each team may also conduct additional fundraising activities to raise money for their chosen organization. All teams must choose a charity to play for and all prize monies will be awarded directly to the charity.

Charities Selected:

Dauphin County Dog Training Club: AKC Canine Health Fund Funds will be targeted for epilepsy and cancer research grants.

Keeshond Club of Delaware Valley: Dog T.A.G.S. Dog T.A.G.S. is a 501(c)3 which means that it is a federally recognized charity. The organization helps veterans suffering from service-related PTSD or Traumatic Brain Injury train their own dogs to be their certified Service Dogs. The organization is totally volunteer - no one gets any remuneration for their work - and the veterans pay nothing to train. Dog T.A.G.S. (Train, Assist, Guide, Serve) pays for all training equipment, vests, facility - everything the handler - dog team might need to attain the status of Service Dog Team. We now have around 60 veterans - men, women, all branches of the service. If the veteran does not have a dog, we work with local Humane Society and rescue organizations to find the veteran a suitable dog. We rely totally on the support of local VFW's, American Legions, individuals and their donations. We have four levels of training and each level runs ten weeks with the veterans passing tests to advance to the next training level with the final goal being to pass the Public Access Test, which requires many skills and the demonstration of three tasks that the dog does for the veteran.

American Bullmastiff Association: ABA Health & Research Fund

Our motto, "committed to a lifetime of wellness", includes collaboration with the Breeders Ed committee of the ABA, participating in recommended health testing, and sharing knowledge with other Bullmastiff fanciers. Currently, the ABA is participating in a clinical trial to identify genes/variants associated with SubAorticStenosis in the Bullmastiff that can be used to develop a genetic test for this condition.

AWARDS

Placement Ribbons will be awarded for the first through fourth place in each height division of each class for Standard Agility Classes and Jumpers with Weaves classes.

First Place: Blue Ribbon; Second Place: Red Ribbon

Third Place: Yellow Ribbon Fourth Place: White Ribbon

A green qualifying ribbon for all qualifying dogs. A qualifying score is required to receive placement awards. New Title, MACH & PACH Ribbons available. **All prizes/ribbons must be claimed the day of the trial.**

SPECIAL AWARDS & RULES FOR THE TEAM CHARITY PRIZES

- The \$500 Point Award Prize will be awarded to the team that has the highest number of MACH & PACH points earned from the Standard & JWW Classes and 25 points for each qualifying run in the Premier Classes Only the team's top 4 qualifying teams scores will be counted.
- The \$500 FAST Award Prize will be awarded based on the total # of FAST points that the all team members earn on Thursday morning.
- The \$500 Q Award Prize will be awarded based on the following rules. This prize will be awarded to the team that has the most # of Q's over the 3 day period, including the FAST Class. All team member Q's will be counted.
- In the event of a tie, the prize money will be split between the winning teams. Ribbons will be awarded based on a random draw.

NEW 2023 TEAM RULES:

- Teams are limited to a total of 6 dog/handler teams.
- All Teams **must** designate a charity to award any winnings.
- **A handler may only enter 2 dogs per team.** Handler may be on multiple teams with other dogs. A dog can only be on one team.
- Dogs do not need to be competing at the Master/Excellent Level to enter the Premier Classes
- Teams must be submitted no later than 8 AM on Tuesday, August 7

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog **before** its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

OBSTACLES & TIMING

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. This trial will be held indoors, ring Dimension 78' x 105' with self-closing gates.

Electronic timing devices will be used.

ROUTES TO THE TRIAL

From I-83:

I-83 to Exit 32 (Newberry exit). **Northbound** – At the light at the bottom of the ramp, turn left onto Rt. 382 North to Lewisberry. Go approximately 3 miles to the flashing traffic light and turn left onto Rt. 177 South toward Rossville. Go approximately 4 miles and turn right on Mt Airy Rd (across from Gifford Pinchot State Park). Continue approximately 1.7 miles to the site on the left. **Southbound** - At the light at the bottom of the ramp turn right onto Rt 382 North to Lewisberry. Follow directions above.

From US-15:

Take Bowmansdale exit Rt. 114 towards Ski Roundtop. At traffic light at the bottom of the hill, proceed straight on South Market St. DO NOT FOLLOW 114. Continue straight about 2.3 miles on South Market St which will become North York Rd. Turn left on East Mt. Airy Rd (at Mt. Pleasant Church of God) and go approximately 4.5 miles. You will pass Ski Roundtop on the right. Continue to a "T" intersection and turn right on Pinetown Rd. Take the first left onto Mt Airy Rd. Site is immediately on the right.

Using a GPS: Use 730 Mt Airy Rd, Lewisberry, PA. Make sure you do not use East Mt Airy Rd.

The Clubs/BVTC reserve the right to change the running order to improve the efficiency of the trial.
A final running order will be included in the Final Confirmation.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is only offered in the Time 2 Beat and FAST classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) (T2B and/or FAST) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handler's hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring.
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog

to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Clubs/ Bella Vista and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Clubs and/or BVTC reserve the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the clubs, BVTC or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

All regulations governing the use of this facility, and all regulations and decisions of the trial committee at this trial will be strictly enforced, including and not limited to the recorded information of this premium list.

Puppies under 4 months of age are prohibited at AKC Agility Trials.

All clubs do not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials offering mixed breed entries), or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number (in trials allowing mixed breed entries) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word “dog” is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog’s physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

All refund requests received prior to the close of entries will be charged a \$5.00 per day processing fee.

A refund of entries minus \$20 per dog per day for injured dogs/bitches in season will be granted when a veterinarian’s letter is presented as proof to the Trial Secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the 1st class of the day of the trial. Must be on official Vet Letter Head.

CRATING and SEATING

Crating will be restricted to the Annex Building. The Show Site Committee reserves the right to alter crating arrangements for space purposes. Exhibitors are responsible for the conditions in and around their own crating area. Tarps must be placed under all crates. X-pens only permitted with prior approval from BVTC. Please email trial secretary with all requests at trialec@bvtrainingcenter.com. No dogs will be permitted to stay overnight in the crating area. Seating space will be available at ringside. Please no oversized chairs, reclining chairs or tables in this area. Please, no dogs permitted in front row.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor’s responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required. Exhibitors may bring their own chairs.

PARKING

Exhibitors are governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities and building and parking regulations. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner’s expense. PLEASE NOTE: A limited number of handicap spaces are available. They will be available on a first-come basis. A valid handicap plate/placard must be on each vehicle using these spaces.

RV/OVERSIZED VEHICLE PARKING: RV’s and Oversized Vehicles are not allowed to park in the regular parking spaces. Oversized Vehicles are defined as those vehicles that do not easily fit in a parking space either by width or length. No trailers.

Club officials may require that vehicles or equipment be rearranged to accommodate additional vehicles. Area around vehicles MUST be kept clean at all times. All vehicles will be parked at owner’s risk. BVTC & the clubs will not be responsible for loss by burglary, fire, or any other cause whatsoever to the vehicle or its contents.

Leashes

All dogs must be on leash at the trial. Retractable leashes are not allowed in the building. Dogs may only be off leash while running the course or at the practice jump. No exhibitors or dogs are allowed behind the row of pine trees to the rear of the Arena.

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767.
